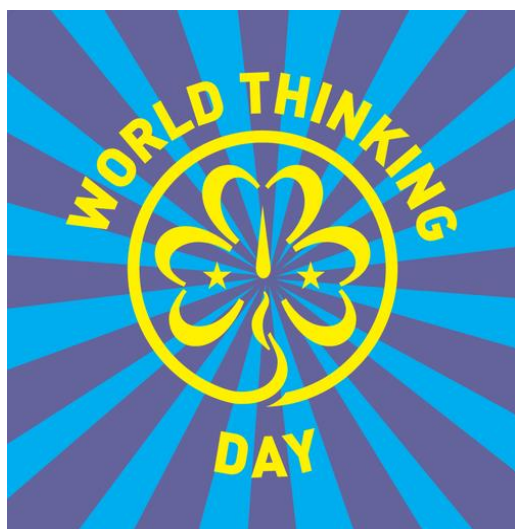


# Assembly
